


# Population Density Change in Pennsylvania Counties 1900-1910



Between 1900 and 1910 Pennsylvania's population density increased by 30.5 persons per square mile. A total of 48 counties experienced an increase in population, 19 counties lost population.

- [White Box] Lost population, decrease in density (19)
- [Light Gray Box] Less than 20.0 persons per square mile increase (8)
- [Light Green Box] 20.0 to 39.9 persons per square mile increase (8)
- [Yellow Box] 40.0 to 59.9 persons per square mile increase (5)
- [Pink Box] 60.0 to 79.9 persons per square mile increase (6)
- [Red Box] 80.0 to 99.9 persons per square mile increase (2)
- [Purple Box] 100.0 to 199.9 persons per square mile increase (2)
- [Dark Purple Box] 200.0 or more persons per square mile increase (2)
