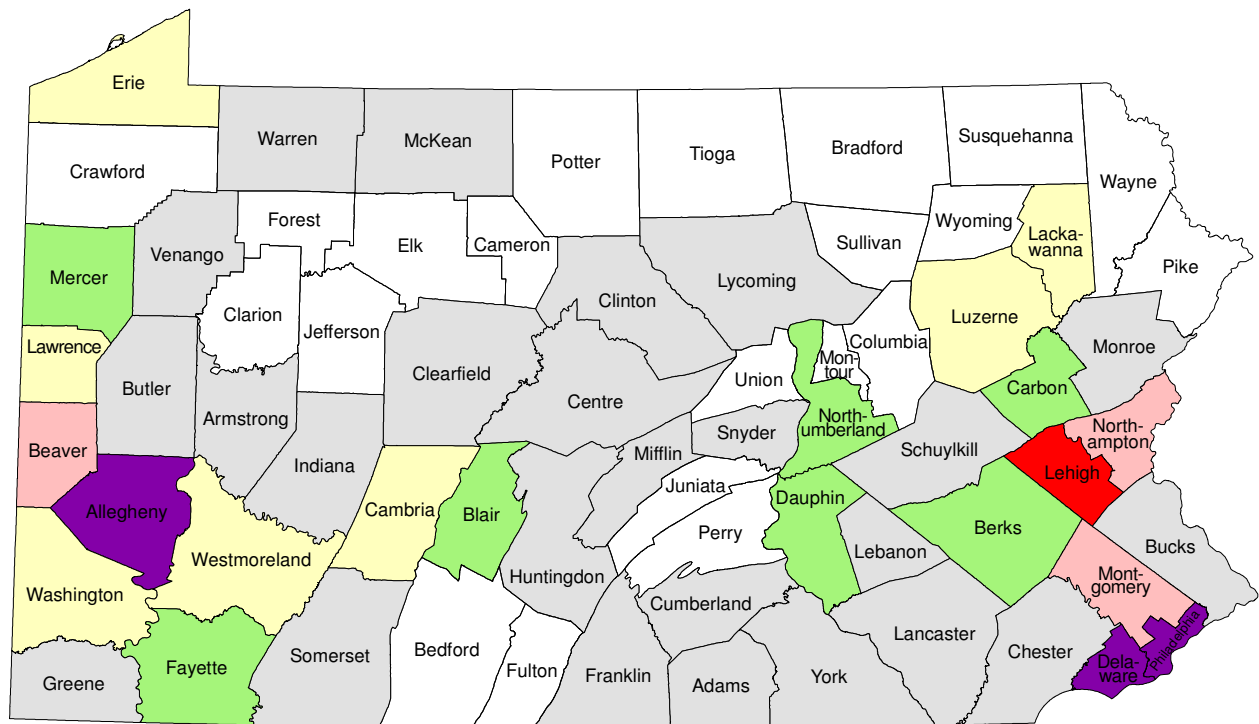


Population Density Change in Pennsylvania Counties 1910-1920



Between 1910 and 1920 Pennsylvania's population density increased by 23.5 persons per square mile. A total of 46 counties experienced an increase in population, 21 counties lost population.
