
Population Density Change in Pennsylvania Counties 1920-1930



Between 1920 and 1930 Pennsylvania's population density increased by 20.4 persons per square mile. A total of 48 counties experienced an increase in population, 19 counties lost population.

Lost population, decrease in density (19)
Less than 20.0 persons per square mile increase (28)
20.0 to 39.9 persons per square mile increase (11)
40.0 to 59.9 persons per square mile increase (2)
60.0 to 79.9 persons per square mile increase (2)
80.0 to 99.9 persons per square mile increase (1)
100.0 to 199.9 persons per square mile increase (1)
200.0 or more persons per square mile increase (3)
