
Population Density Change in Pennsylvania Counties 1950-1960



Between 1950 and 1960 Pennsylvania's population density increased by 18.4 persons per square mile. A total of 43 counties experienced an increase in population, 24 counties lost population.

20.0 to 39.9 persons per square mile increase (8)
40.0 to 59.9 persons per square mile increase (4)
60.0 to 79.9 persons per square mile increase (2)
80.0 to 99.9 persons per square mile increase (1)
100.0 to 199.9 persons per square mile increase (1)
200 0 or more persons per square mile increase (3)
