
Population Density Change in Pennsylvania Counties 1990-2000



Between 1990 and 2000 Pennsylvania's population density increased by 8.9 persons per square mile. A total of 48 counties experienced an increase in population, 19 counties lost population.

Lost population, decrease in density (19)

Less than 20.0 persons per square mile increase (34)

20.0 to 39.9 persons per square mile increase (5)

40.0 to 59.9 persons per square mile increase (4)

60.0 to 79.9 persons per square mile increase (3)

200.0 or more persons per square mile increase (0)
