

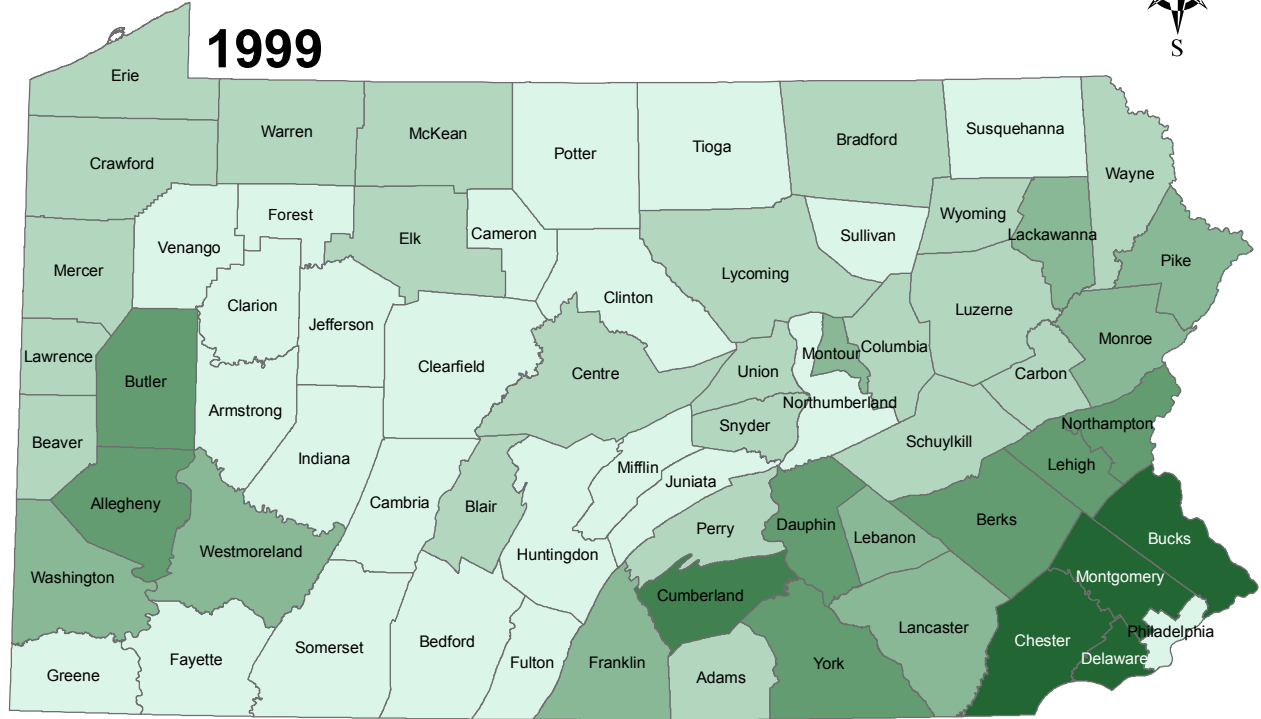
PENNSYLVANIA COUNTY PER CAPITA INCOME



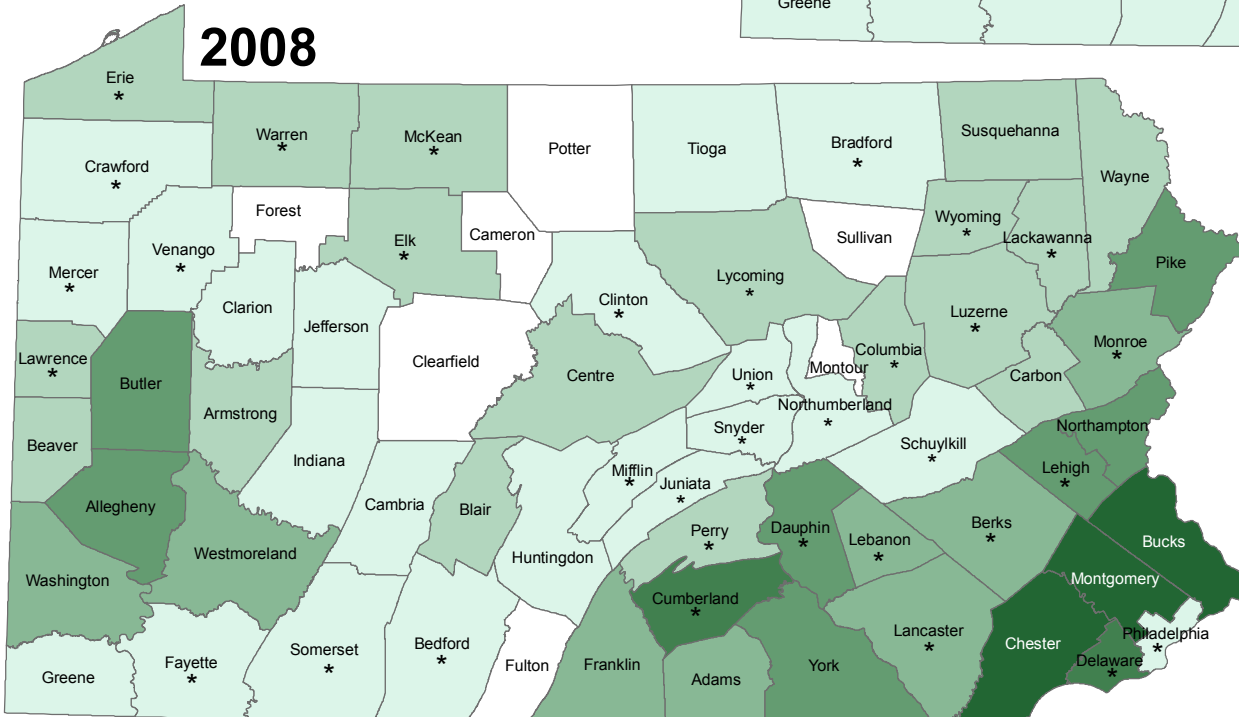
Per Capita Income is the average money income received for every man, woman, and child in a geographic area. It is derived by dividing the total income of all people 15 years old and over in a geographic area by the total population in that area.

The information that is being displayed represents the Per Capita Income for each of the counties in PA. The Per Capita Income for each county is in terms of comparison to the statewide average. The statewide average in 1999 was \$20,880 (100%) and \$27,025 (100%) in 2008. For example: Union County had the most significant change in comparison to the statewide average. In 1999 Union County had a Per Capita Income of \$17,918, which represented 85.5% of the statewide average. In 2008 Union County had a Per Capita Income of \$21,195, which represented 78.4% of the statewide average. Therefore, Union County declined in comparison to the statewide average from 1999 to 2008.

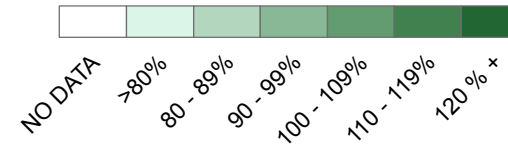
