
## Population Density Change in Pennsylvania Counties 2010-2011



Between 2010 and 2011 the U.S. Census Bureau estimates Pennsylvania's population density increased 0.9 persons per square mile. During that time, a total of 37 counties are estimated to have increased in population while 30 counties decreased.

Lost population, decrease in density (30)

0 - 1.9 persons per square mile increase (26)

2.0 - 3.9 persons per square mile increase (4)

4.0 - 5.9 persons per square mile increase (3)

6.0 - 7.9 persons per square mile increase (1)

8.0 - 9.9 persons per square mile increase (2)

10.0 - 19.9 persons per square mile increase (0)

20.0 or more persons per square mile increase (1)
