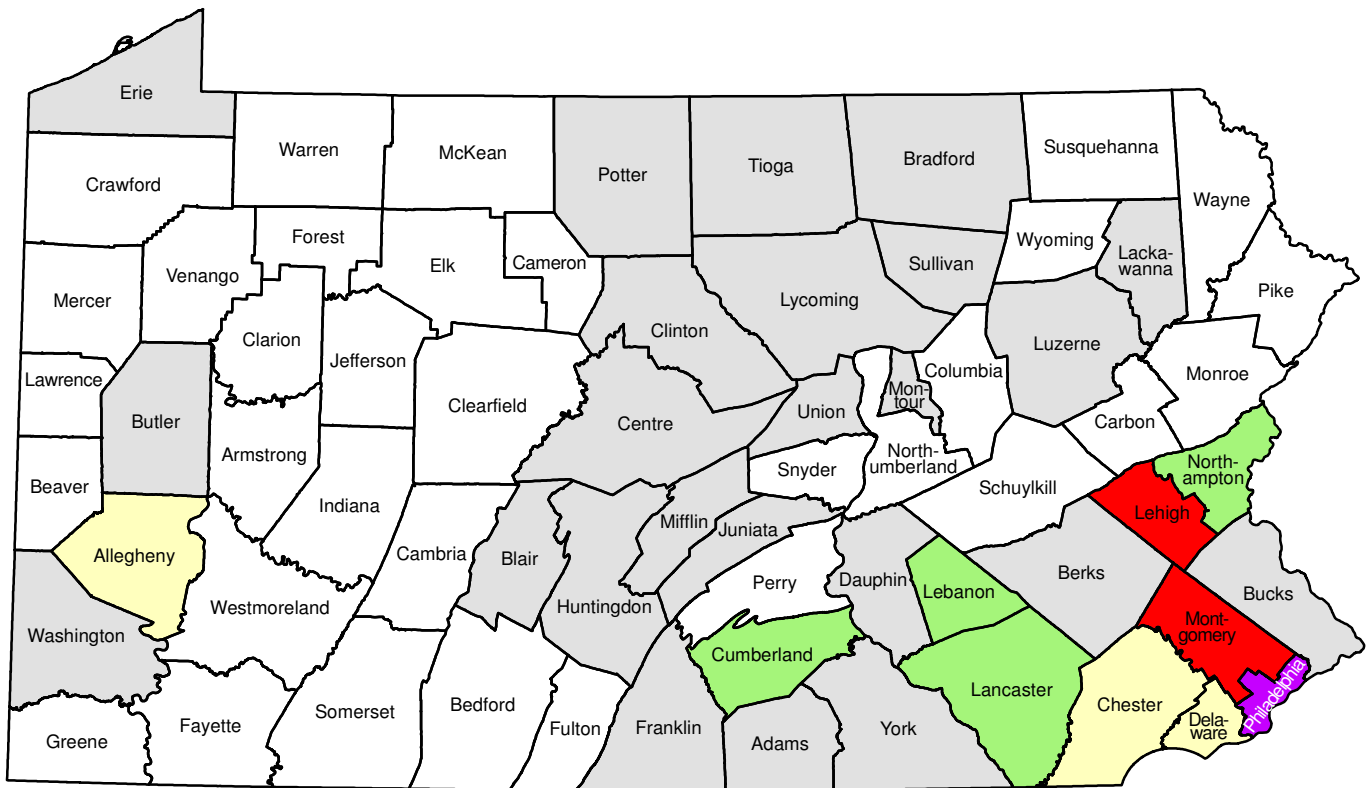


# Population Density Change in Pennsylvania Counties 2010-2012



Between 2010 and 2012 the U.S. Census Bureau estimates Pennsylvania's population density increased 1.4 persons per square mile. During that time, a total of 34 counties are estimated to have increased in population while 33 counties decreased.
