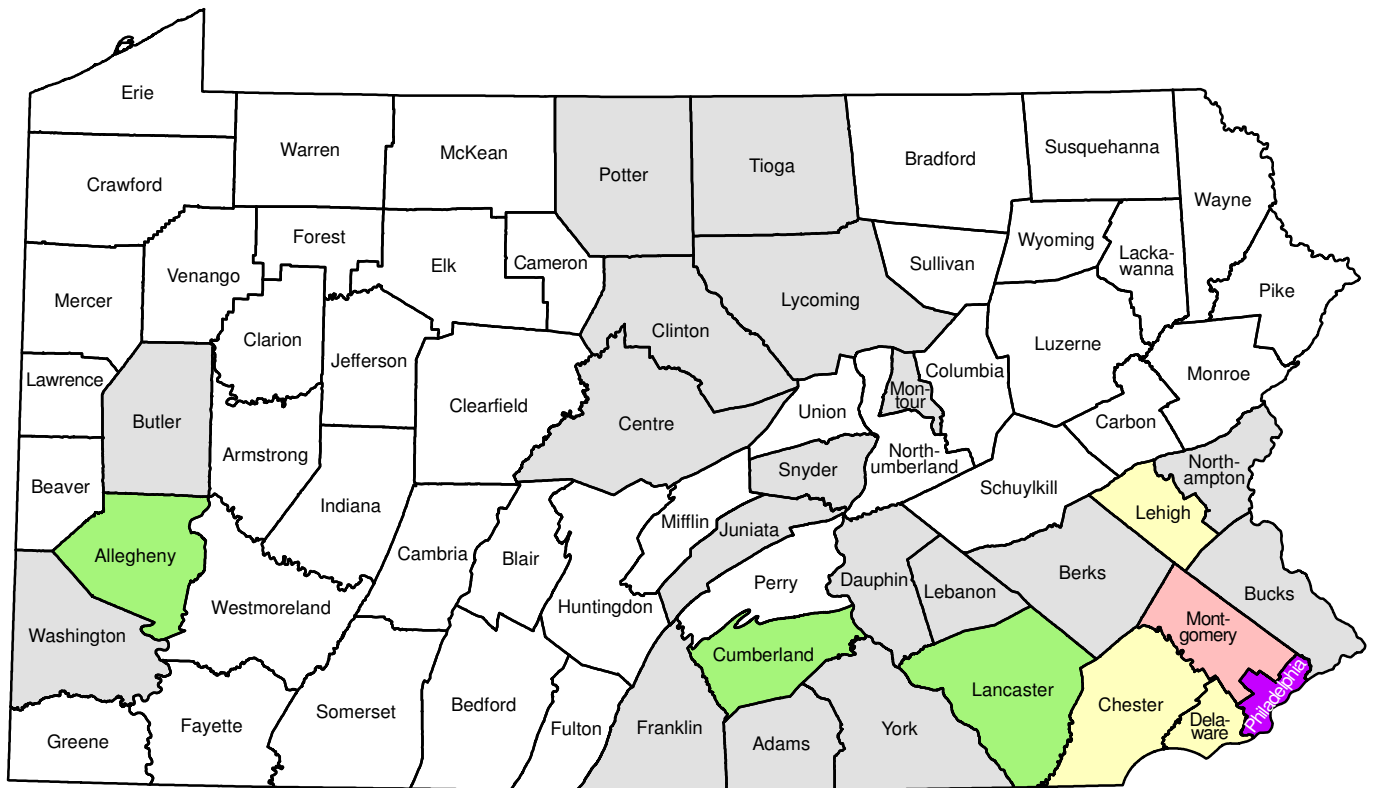


Population Density Change in Pennsylvania Counties 2010-2013



Between 2010 and 2013 the U.S. Census Bureau estimates Pennsylvania's population density increased 1.6 persons per square mile. During that time, a total of 26 counties are estimated to have increased in population while 41 counties decreased.
