
Population Density Change in Pennsylvania Counties 2010-2014



Between 2010 and 2014 the U.S. Census Bureau estimates Pennsylvania's population density increased 1.9 persons per square mile. During that time, a total of 25 counties are estimated to have increased in population while 42 counties decreased.

Lost population, decrease in density (42)

0 - 7.9 persons per square mile increase (17)

8.0 - 15.9 persons per square mile increase (3)

16.0 - 23.9 persons per square mile increase (2)

24.0 - 31.9 persons per square mile increase (1)

32.0 - 39.9 persons per square mile increase (1)

40.0 - 79.9 persons per square mile increase (0)

80.0 or more persons per square mile increase (1)
