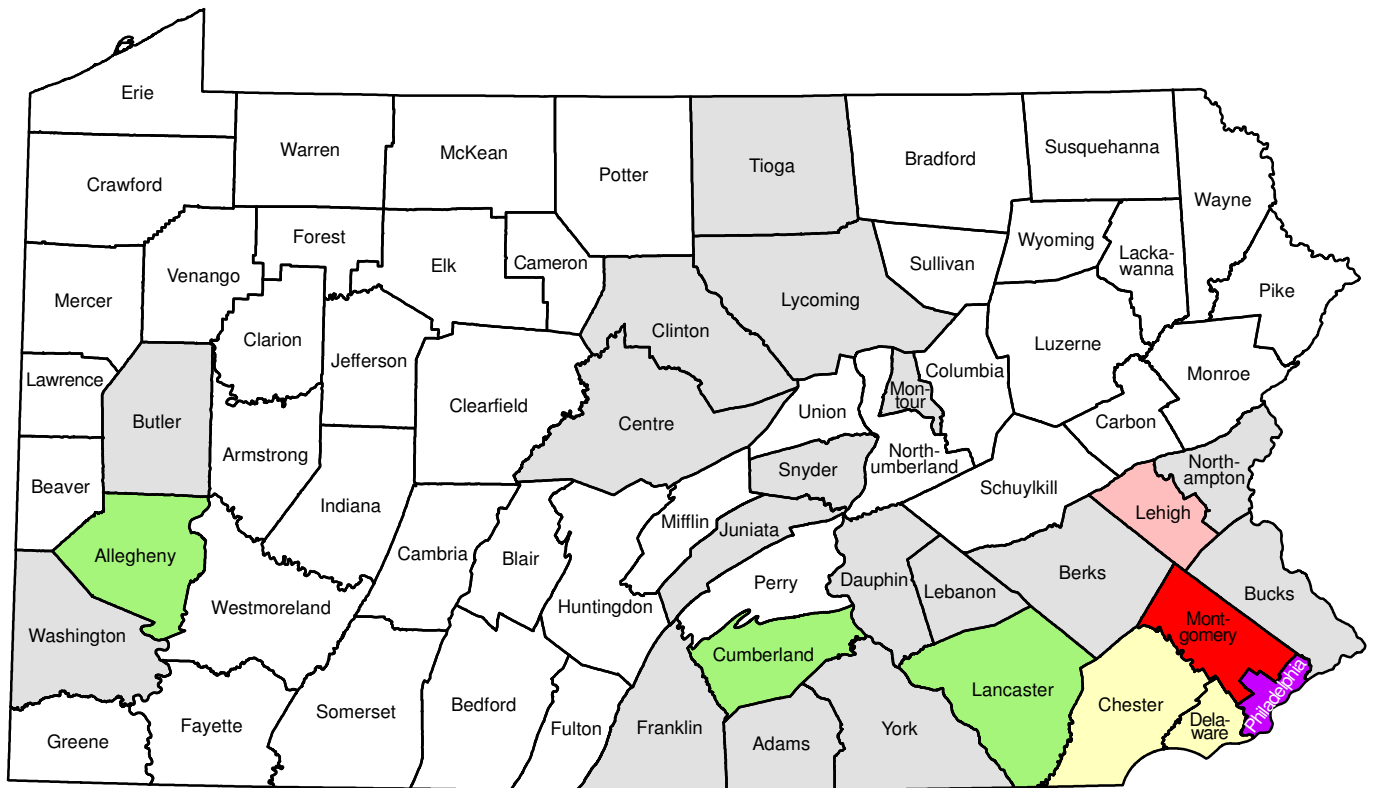


# Population Density Change in Pennsylvania Counties 2010-2014



Between 2010 and 2014 the U.S. Census Bureau estimates Pennsylvania's population density increased 1.9 persons per square mile. During that time, a total of 25 counties are estimated to have increased in population while 42 counties decreased.
